



FREE preceptorship programme for Social Care Nurses

Warrington & Vale Royal College is running a 9-month long pilot programme, in partnership with Cheshire and Merseyside ICB and the Primary Care Training Hub, to provide new social care nurses with support and opportunities for professional development.

How will the programme be delivered?

The programme will be delivered through a series of practical in-person sessions in our Health & Social Care Academy and some online tutorial sessions.

A variety of topics will be covered that have been specifically designed to enhance and support knowledge of nursing in the social care sector.

What support will be available?

Students will have a mentor within their workplace and an on-programme tutor who will provide support during their initial months working in the sector.

What are the entry requirements?

Students must have cooperation from their employing organisation to have a place on the programme, as well as an agreement that they will support attendance at taught sessions, as this is vital.

At the end of the programme, students will be asked to engage with Warrington & Vale Royal College about their experience.
